


Faith for Earth: UNEA 4

Challenge:


- Tracing a path that all can follow

Baha'i Writings:

- Nature in its essence is the embodiment of My name, the Maker, the Creator.
- Nature is God's Will and is its expression in and through the contingent world.
- The root causes lie in moral questions of consumption and excessive materialism that are associated with the exploitation and degradation of the environment
- Therefore: Humanity would be best and most effectively served by... pursuing united action that is informed by the best available scientific evidence and grounded in spiritual/moral principles, and thoughtfully revising action in the light of experience.

- Study Circles
